**Susquehanna Folk Music Society Inc.** \$3,000 \$ \_\_\_\_\_

The Susquehanna Folk Music Society in collaboration with the York County Convention and Visitors Bureau will present a series of traditional arts events that will provide opportunities for the York community to experience the richness and variety of American culture.

**York County Heritage Trust** \$5,000 \$ \_\_\_\_\_

The Trust proposes a partnership with Rivertownes PA USA, a non-profit based in Wrightsville, to organize a collaborative commemoration around the Sesquicentennial of the Civil War, specifically highlighting General Gordon's march through York and the burning of the Wrightsville-Columbia bridge.

**York County Rail Trail Authority** \$3,500 \$ \_\_\_\_\_

To conduct a York County recreational tourism promotion of county parks, trails and outdoor attractions. The project is to conduct a one year pilot project promoting York County's recreational assets through a tourism strategy called "Stay and Play in York, PA". The project’s purpose or rationale is to expand upon the marketing themes currently being used to attract visitors to York County by adding the element of recreation.

**Creating Opportunities in Neighborhood Environments, Inc. (CONE) \$5,000** \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
To match state and federal funding to purchase/rehabilitate/resell 4 vacant residential properties for homeownership in the Olde Towne East neighborhood in York City as part of the Elm Street revitalization initiative.

**West York Area School District** \$5,000 \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
Time to HEAR: Helping Elementary Schools Amplify Rooms provides sound field amplification systems in West York School District that streamlines and updates technology offered to students in LIU #12's Deaf/Hard of Hearing Support Program.

**HEALTH & HUMAN NEEDS**

**Easter Seals Central Pennsylvania** \$5,000 \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
To support the continued growth and development of the Therapeutic Recreation Programs (including horseback riding, Autism social programs and camps of all types) in York County.

**Family Promise of Harrisburg Capital Region** \$4,000 \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
Located in Dillsburg, Family Promise provides housing, meals & support for homeless families. A van is used to transport guests to and from the churches where they are staying to the Day Center where they receive assistance with finding work, housing and other resources. Money will be used towards gas and maintenance of the van.

**Memorial Hospital** \$5,000 \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
Memorial Hospital's weight management program, Fit and Fabulous, will assist women in the systematic process of weight loss and weight management.

**National Multiple Sclerosis Society Central PA Chapter** \$5,000 \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
The Foundation is funding supplies for What a Difference a Day Makes, which engages volunteers to assist people with MS with home projects and chores. The \$5000 request is for staff support to work with the individuals participating in the What a Difference event to develop a realistic plan to maintain independence and improve quality of life.

**Pregnancy & Family Resource Center** \$2,000 \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
This project will expand the Parent Education Program to include specific modules about childhood nutrition and play that are visually appealing and practical and offering incentives for participation. The project serves low income women and families who are pregnant and/or parenting young children.

**St. Joseph Parish** \$5,000 \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
Renovation and expansion of the food pantry parking lot for safer and more accessible parking that allows the Pantry to operate at a higher capacity.

**York City Bureau of Health** \$4,250 \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
The York City Bureau of Health will initiate its first strategic planning process to develop a strategic framework for public health services for the next 3 - 5 years. Funding will be used to pay for a consultant and meeting expenses.

**York Jewish Community Center** \$4,900 \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
To provide requested diversity services in the 14 York County schools that do not have the available funds to pay for these services.
