



## Our Current Grantees

### **Cultural Alliance of York County**

Grant Amount: \$15,000

Fund: Women's Giving Circle Fund

Description of Program: This grant will be used to develop and implement a public art program in York City.

### **Downtown Inc**

Grant Amount: \$6,360

Fund: YorIt Social Venture Fund

Description of Program: This grant was used by Downtown Inc to host its 2010 summer concert series called SPLASH! These free outdoor concerts, held at the Codorus Boat Basin and Foundry Park in downtown York, draw hundreds of spectators on Saturday nights throughout the summer.

### **Downtown Inc**

Grant Amount: \$5,000

Fund: Women's Giving Circle Fund

Description of Program: This grant was used to launch a new Destination Guide for Downtown York designed to appeal to young professionals and college students. It was distributed strategically to reach this target demographic.

### **Farm and Natural Lands Trust of York County**

Grant Amount: \$10,000

Fund: Robert R. Anderson Family Fund

Description of Program: The Agricultural and Land Preservation Committee administers the Robert R. Anderson Family Fund. The proceeds of this grant were used to support the general operating expenses of the Farm and Natural Lands Trust to preserve farms and other valuable lands.

### **Leadership York**

Grant Amount: \$15,000

Fund: Fund for York County

Description of Program: This grant supported the 2010 – 2011 Future Leaders of York (FLY) program which teaches high school students from across York County how to get engaged in civic life and give back to the community. Students meet monthly throughout the school year to participate in community service, travel to nonprofit settings and engage in a grant making process that awards \$4,000 to area nonprofits.

### **Leg Up Farm, Inc.**

Grant Amount: \$5,000

Fund: Energy Conservation Fund

Description of Program: Leg Up Farm, located in Manchester Township, offers therapy and support services for children with disabilities and their families. The Energy Conservation Fund gave Leg Up Farm \$5,000 to assist with the design of a Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certified energy efficient building. The project resulted in a LEED SILVER certified building that will save the grantee approximately \$16,000 per year or 160,000 kilowatt hours of electricity annually.

### **New Birth of Freedom Council, Boy Scouts of America**

Grant Amount: \$15,000

Fund: Fund for York County

Description of Program: This grant was awarded to facilitate the creation of a new boy scout council serving south-central Pennsylvania through the consolidation of the former Keystone Area and York-Adams Area councils.

### **Pennsylvania Environmental Council**

Grant Amount: \$52,000

Fund: Codorus Watershed Fund

Description of Program: The Codorus Watershed Committee partners with the Pennsylvania Environmental Council in a \$52,000 contract with Ecostruction, LLC to provide technical assistance to landowners and municipalities to implement best management practices that protect the Codorus Watershed.

### **Pennsylvania Environmental Council**

Grant Amount: \$16,000

Fund: Robert R. Anderson Family Fund

Description of Program: The Agricultural and Land Preservation Committee administers the Robert R. Anderson Family Fund which partners with the Pennsylvania Environmental Council in a \$16,000 contract with Ecostruction, LLC to provide technical assistance to farmers to implement best management practices for the streams and creeks that run through their properties.

**Pennsylvania Environmental Council**

Grant Amount: \$54,260

Fund: Energy Conservation Fund

Description of Program: The Energy Conservation Committee partners with the Pennsylvania Environmental Council in a \$54,260 contract with Energy Opportunities Inc. to provide technical assistance and education in energy efficiency strategies for nonprofits and government.

Grant Amount: \$66,150

Fund: Alliance for the Chesapeake Bay

Description of Program: This grant is a partnership with the Alliance for the Chesapeake Bay to offer a Circuit Rider Program in York County that implements strategies to protect the Chesapeake Bay Watershed. Find out more at <https://allianceforthebay.org>

**Pennsylvania Environmental Council**

Grant Amount: \$10,000

Fund: Energy Conservation Fund

Description of Program: This grant helped York County attain Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certification for the York County Government Center.

**Strand-Capitol Performing Arts Center**

Grant Amount: \$5,000

Fund: Fund for York County

Description of Program: This grant supported the Strand-Capitol Performing Arts Center's strategic alliance with The York Symphony Orchestra to enhance collaborative opportunities. The Symphony moved into office space at the Strand-Capitol giving them access to the computer network, telephone system and Box Office services offered by the Strand-Capitol.

## **The Hahn Home**

Grant Amount: \$296,500

Fund: Hahn Home Fund

Description of Program: The Hahn Home Fund was established to provide for the general support of the former elderly residents of the Hahn Home and address the needs of older women... The Hahn Home Advisory Committee completed a report on the needs of older women in York County and will be announcing a grant program to address those needs later in 2011.

## **United Way of York County**

Grant Amount: \$12,979

Fund: Focus on Our Future Fund

Program Description: This fund was established to support the Focus on Our Future Program, the early childhood education initiative of the United Way of York County, by working to enhance the quality of early childhood education throughout York County.

## **William F. Goodling Regional Advanced Skills Center**

Grant Amount: \$10,000

Fund: Fund for York County

Program Description: This grant was awarded to support the William Goodling Advanced Skills Center and the Manufacturer's Association of South Central Pennsylvania's alliance to strengthen the connection between training skilled workers and the industries that need them.

## **Y Community Development Corporation**

Grant Amount: \$17,000

Fund: Fund for York County

Program Description: This grant was used to facilitate the merger of the Housing Alliance of York and the Housing Initiatives Community Development Corporation into the Y Community Development Corporation (YMCA of York and York County). The organizations are joining forces to maximize their strengths in housing development and provide housing services to those in need.

## **YMCA of York and York County**

Grant Amount: \$43,750

Funds: Women's Giving Circle Fund and Fund for York County

Program Description: The Women's Giving Circle and the Fund for York County jointly awarded \$43,750 in 2010 – 2011 to the YMCA for a Community Resource Coordinator to provide technical assistance and training to York City neighborhood associations to empower them to improve the quality of life in their neighborhoods. ### **York City Bureau of Health**

Grant Amount: \$93,608

Fund: Albert Weyer Community Health Fund

Program Description: The Albert Weyer Community Health Fund provides annual support to the York City Bureau of Health located at the Albert S. Weyer Health Center, 435 West Philadelphia Street, York, PA so they can continue to offer free health services to York City residents.

### **York College of Pennsylvania**

Grant Amount: \$15,000

Fund: Fund for York County

Program Description: The Fund for York County along with other area funders provided a \$15,000 grant to support the work of the York Nonprofit Management Development Center and its project Moving Community Plans Into Action. The project will collect, catalogue and organize community based plans; study the plans, looking for patterns, overlaps, contradictions, points of intersections, etc; convert the data into information this is unbiased and useful; and track implementation progress and make recommendations for implementation.

### **York County Alliance for Learning**

Grant Amount: \$15,000

Fund: Fund for York County

Program Description: This grant was awarded to support a strategic alliance between York County Alliance for Learning (YCAL) and York County Economic Development Corporation to better link high school students with careers in business.

### **York Town Craft Guild**

Grant Amount: \$6,350

Fund: Margaret "Peggy" Knoch Memorial Fund

Program Description: The York Town Craft Guild is a chapter of the Pennsylvania Guild of Craftsman and nurtures the excellence in crafts through education and support of practicing

craftsmen. Funds provided by this grant are used to fund the purchase of equipment, pay instructors fees and materials for the many workshops offered by the Guild in addition to funding building maintenance and insurance costs.

### YorkCounts

Grant Amount: \$30,000

Fund: Fund for York County

Program Description: This grant provides general support to YorkCounts, a community-based non-partisan coalition working to assess, sustain, and enhance the quality of life in York County.

### YorkCounts

Grant amount: \$10,000

Fund: Fund for York County

Program Description: YorkCounts will use this grant to work with representatives from 9 municipalities covering 5 police departments to conduct a study on the feasibility of establishing a Metro-York regional police department.
