



## **Hahn Home Grant Program for Aging Women - 2011**

---

**Goal of Hahn Home Program:** Help women age with dignity, independence and health.

**Competitive Grant Program:** \$175,000 available for grantmaking

**Grant Award Size:** Individual grants made up to \$175,000. Multi-year grants will be considered.

**Focus Areas/Objectives for Grantmaking:**

1. Create supportive communities to help women, age 55 and older, maintain independent living in their residence of choice.
2. Improve access to services for aging women and caregivers through better communication, education and outreach.
3. Improve the quality of elder care through education of caregivers and direct care workers.

**Hahn Home Fund Priorities:**

- Benefit aging women with limited financial resources and other support
- Help aging women maintain their independence
- Coordination and collaboration among service providers
- High impact results (strategic initiatives, long-term solutions, system changes)
- Support best practices or evidence-based projects and programs
- Improve the quality of services to aging women
- Well-defined communication and outreach strategies to older residents and their caregivers
- Raise the level of community awareness about the needs of aging women
- Potential to leverage additional resources for the community
- Strategy for sustainability

**Grant Application Guidelines**

1. Grant applicants must be charitable 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations, educational bodies, or government agencies serving York County. Organizations without 501(c)(3) status may collaborate with a fiscal agent that is a 501(c)(3).

2. Grants are **NOT provided** for:
  - Projects that are unrelated, or marginally related, to the goals of the grant program.
  - Endowment, capital campaigns, budget shortfalls, or debt retirement.
  - Multiple projects to the same grant program.
  - Religious projects.
  - Organizations with discriminatory employment or program practices.
  - Association Dues.
  - Scholarship, travel, conferences, or any form of direct financial assistance to individuals.
3. **Application to one grant program does not preclude the applicant from applying for other York County Community Foundation grant programs.**
4. **Applicants must be current with post-grant reports for past projects funded by York County Community Foundation to be eligible to apply for new project funding.**

### **Grant Award Process:**

- June 29, 2011: Announce Hahn Home grant program at the former Hahn Home now the home of Kuhner Associates, 863 South George Street, York, PA.
  - October 1, 2011: Grant Proposals are due to the Foundation. Applicants are strongly encouraged to discuss their proposal with Jane Conover, VP Community Investment prior to submitting a proposal. Contact Jane at [jconover@yccf.org](mailto:jconover@yccf.org) or 717.848.3733.
  - November 8, 2011: Hahn Home Committee reviews proposals/interviews applicants and makes recommendations for grant awards to the York County Community Foundation Board of Directors.
  - December 15, 2011: Grants approved by YCCF Board.
  - January 1, 2012: Grant period begins.
